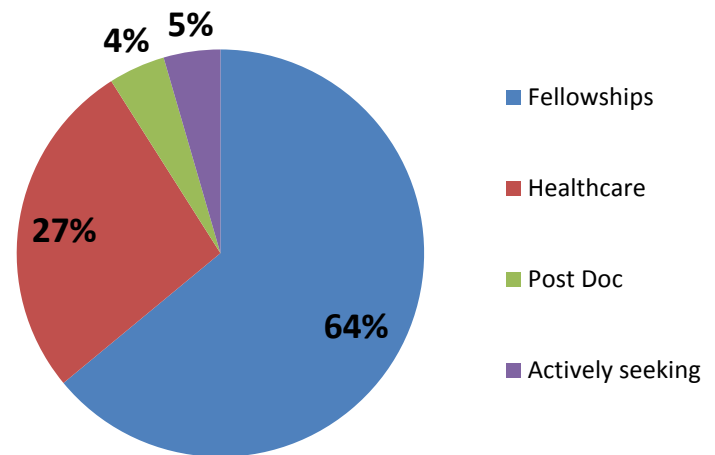
- Average salary: \$53,128

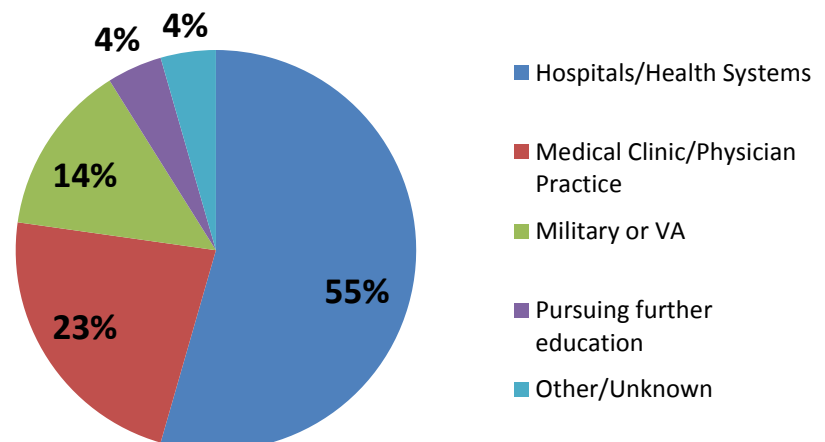
